Friendly Reminders

- Stay prepared for freezing temperatures: Always keep your heat set at a minimum of 65 degrees Fahrenheit. Let your faucets drip in the kitchen and bathrooms. This allows the water to have a constant flow and prevent pipes from freezing. Keep your garage door closed when not in use. Open cabinets during extended periods of below-freezing temperatures so that the warm air can reach pipes along exterior walls.
- Snow removal and parking: Be sure to have your driveway and walking path leading up to your door shoveled and clear of snow.
 Curbside and alleyway parking is prohibited during/after a snowfall, for plow trucks to access and clear the neighborhood safely.
