COMMUNITY POLICY REFRESHER

As part of keeping our community safe, clean, and enjoyable for all residents, we ask everyone to take a moment to review these key policies:

- All our properties are located on **Federal land**, where marijuana use is illegal.
- To prevent late fees, rent and utilities must be paid by the 1st of the month with a grace period of 5 days.
- If you anticipate an upcoming move, a 30-day notice must be provided to avoid paying rent for days that you're not actually residing in the home. We will accept notices up to 90 days in advance.
- Pets must always **be "on leash"**. Pets shall not be tethered outside the home at any time. If an owner's pet constitutes a threat to the health and safety of other residents or animals, a 10-day notice to terminate the lease will be provided to the leaseholder.
- Parking: Park only in designated areas and avoid blocking driveways, hydrants, and sidewalks. As the snow season approaches, please ensure your vehicle is not parked on the street.
- Noise Awareness: Please be mindful of noise, especially during quiet hours.
- Solicitation is prohibited on federal property. Please remain cautious of individuals attempting to sell goods or services in the area. If you're unsure about any activity, North Chicago Police Department after hours.

Thank you for helping us maintain a respectful and well-kept community.

HOLIDAY SAFETY TIPS

As we head into the holiday season, please take a moment to review a few safety reminders.

- Pick up packages promptly to help prevent porch theft.
- Holiday Lights: Inspect cords for damage, avoid daisy-chaining multiple extension cords, and unplug decorations before bed.
- **Be mindful of kitchen safety**—holiday cooking is the #1 cause of seasonal fires.
- Keep space heaters at least 3 feet away from anything flammable.
- **Keep live trees watered** to prevent them from drying out and becoming a fire hazard.

• **Blow out candles** before leaving the room. Use flameless candles keep them out of the reach of pets children, and flammable materials such as curtains.

- **Heading out of town?** Before you go, make sure your home is secure: lock all doors and windows, pause package deliveries, and consider letting a trusted neighbor know you'll be away.
- **Deep-Frying Turkey**: Fry outdoors on a flat non-flammable surface, make sure oil is completely cool before moving or disposing.
- **Fire and Coal Disposal:** Let coal and ashes cool for 48 hours before disposing in a metal container, not plastic or paper. Never dump warm coals in the trash or on the ground.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

As colder weather approaches, here are a few maintenance tips to help you stay prepared for the Midwest winter.

- Set your thermostat to a constant temperature to help prevent fluctuations that might lead to freezing or pipe bursting.
- When going away, please DO NOT TURN OFF YOUR
 HEAT. Instead, set your temperature no lower than
 57 *F. Also, never use an oven to heat your home.
- Disconnect garden hoses from hose bibs to avoid a pipe burst.
- Clear your utility closet and under-sink area: This allows our technicians easy access and ensures there are no surprises during the inspection.



- **Preventive maintenance** will be conducted at **Forrestal Village** in December to help maintain your home in top condition. Residents will be given at least **48 hours' notice** prior to any entry.
- Home Care: If you notice leaks, running toilets, or maintenance concerns, submit a work order promptly. Our team is available 24/7 to assist with emergencies.
