MAINTENANCE AND TRASH TIPS

As cooler temperatures begin to arrive, September is the perfect time to prepare your home for the fall season. A little preventative maintenance now can help avoid larger issues later.

Keep your AC running smoothly by following these important tips.

- Don't block vents with furniture, boxes, and other belongings.
- Change your air filter regularly and ask us if you're unsure how.
- Report issues early before the heat hits hard.
- Keep blinds closed during peak sunlight hours to keep temperatures down.
- Avoid overloading electrical outlets with fans or cooling units.
- Remember, emergency maintenance is available 24/7 by calling (847) 999-6228.

Trash Tips

- Break down all cardboard boxes before placing them in recycling or trash bins.
- Always bag your trash before disposing of it to help control odors, prevent spills, and keep pest away.
- Clean garbage bins regularly with soap and water or a vinegar solution every few weeks to maintain hygiene.
- Store garbage cans in shaded, dry areas ideally inside a garage to reduce the risk of pest activity.
